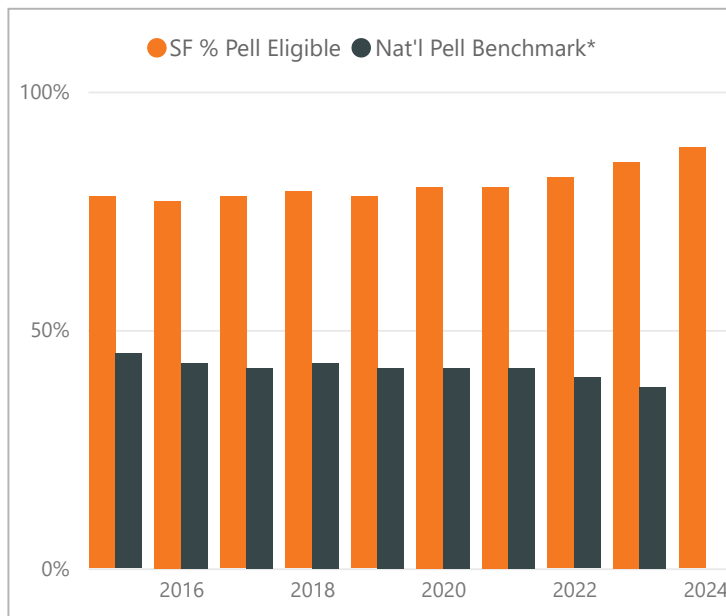




The Scholarship Foundation of St. Louis - Key Performance Indicators (KPI)

The proportion of Scholarship Foundation (SF) students who are eligible for federal Pell Grants exceeds the national benchmark by **40 percentage points**.



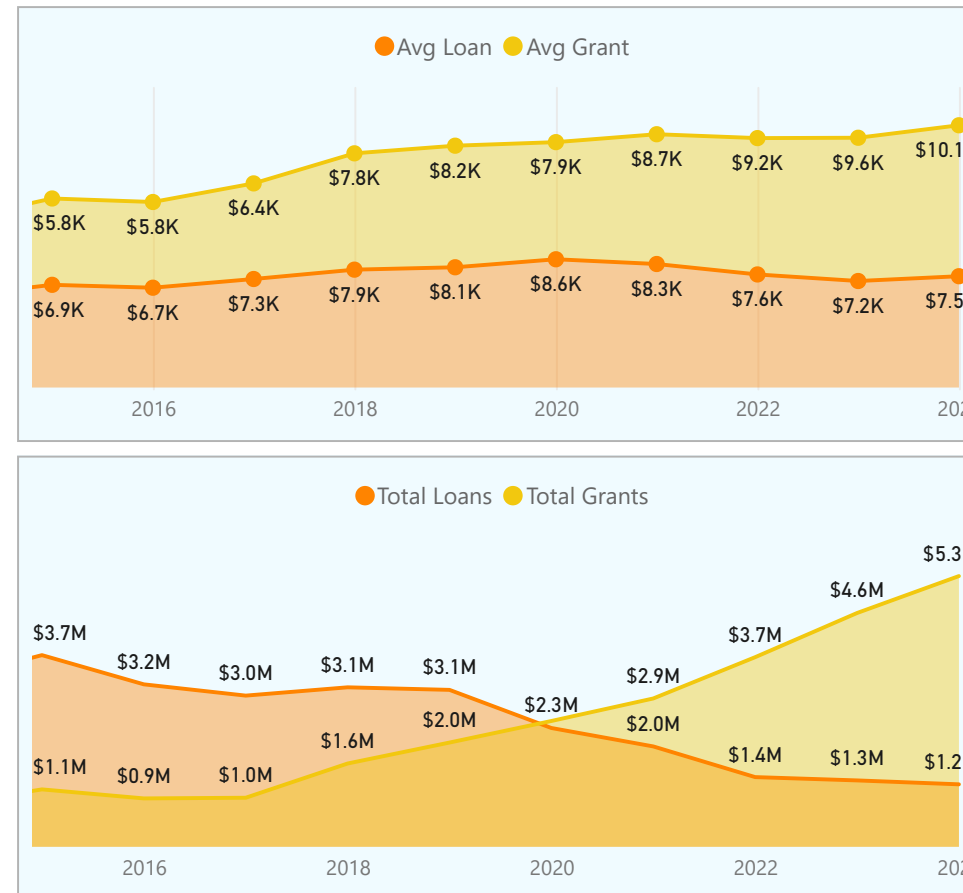
We collect data from the FAFSA, and use it to make sure our programs are **consistently** directed toward students with the **greatest** financial need.
