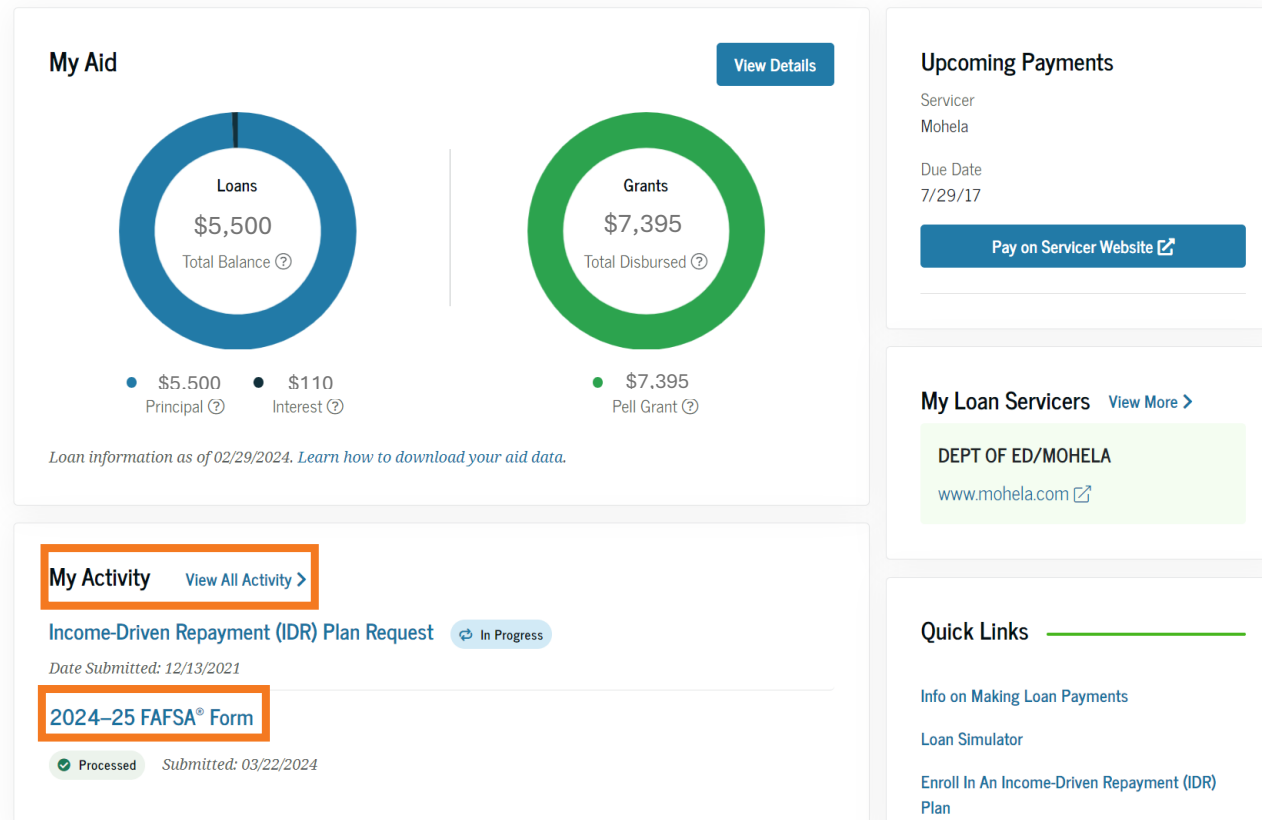


How to Access Your FAFSA Submission Summary


1. Log into your StudentAid.Gov account using your FSA ID.
2. Scroll down to “My Activity” and click “2024-25 FAFSA Form.” If you do not see that click “View All Activity.”

3. Your FAFSA Submission Summary will be available once your FAFSA is processed with all the required signatures. After selecting the 2024-25 FAFSA Form, scroll down. Select the blue button that says “FAFSA Submission Summary”.

Status Tracker

The student should complete most of the form themselves, including their personal and financial information. You must fill out the section assigned to you. If you can't access the site due to scheduled maintenance, you will be able to log in once the site is available again. The student's data is still in the system and is secure. Estimated Federal Student Aid

Federal Direct Loans
A federal direct loan is money lent by the government to you that you must repay with interest. Up to **\$9,500**

Federal Work-Study
Federal Work-Study is a way for students to earn money to pay for school through part-time jobs on or off campus. You May Be Eligible

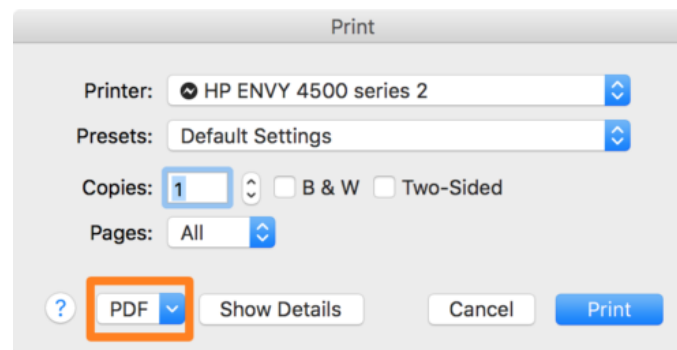
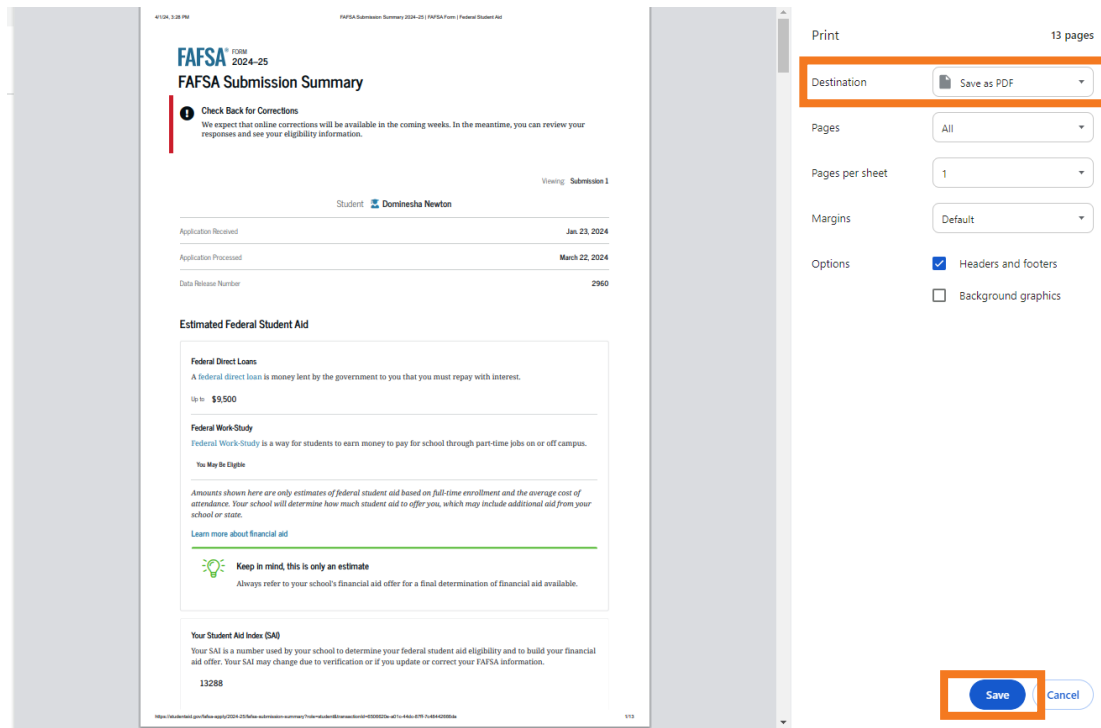

2. Click “Add New File.”
3. Click “Browse” and locate the screenshot of your FAFSA Submission Summary.
4. SELECT the document.
5. Click “Save and Keep Editing.”
